OPTION 2: Writing	Sentences are very well-written (<i>include a capital letter at the start of the sentence, proper punctuation, subject/verb/object word order, etc.</i>) with few grammatical errors (<i>spelling, punctuation, syntax, etc.</i>)	Sentences are understandable and often well-written, but may have some grammatical errors (<i>spelling, punctuation, syntax, etc.</i>)	Sentences are not often well-written (<i>include a capital letter at the start of the sentence, proper punctuation, subject/verb/object word order, etc.</i>), and have many grammatical errors (<i>spelling, punctuation, syntax, etc.</i>)	Writing is very difficult to understand because of grammatical errors
